POSITION DESCRIPTION

- ← Arrange campus presentations for the education of students, faculty, and administrators with regards the importance of clean energy technologies.
- ← Work with student leaders to hold educational events, collaborate with relevant student organizations, and organize meetings with campus faculty and administration.
- ← Organize resources and materials for campuses planning clean energy campaigns.
- ← Provide resources and support to students concerning local media, and encourage students to publicize their efforts through local and regional media.
- ← Coordinate student work with ally organizations including: Energy Action, Southern Energy Network, Sierra Club, and Greenpeace.
